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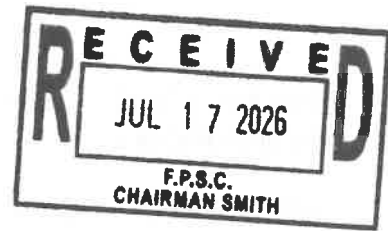

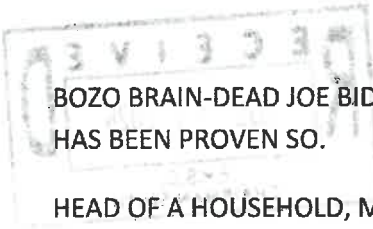
STOP THIS NOW !

NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

Notice of Interim Rate Increase

On April 20, 2026, Florida City Gas ("Company") filed a request for a rate increase with the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") asking for a permanent increase in rates, as well as an interim increase in rates pending the Commission's decision in this case, which has been assigned Docket No. 20260026-GU. The Commission is the agency, under Florida law, charged with setting and regulating the rates, fees, and services of Florida utilities and will review the Company's request.

The Company is asking that the Commission allow the Company to increase its rates and charges to the extent necessary to generate additional gross annual revenues in the amount of \$46.9 million, which will enable the Company to continue to provide safe, reliable natural gas service at a level the customers have come to expect. The Company has used a projected test year of January 1, 2027, through December 31, 2027, for purposes of presenting its case, and believes this time period best represents actual conditions in effect at the time new rates will go into effect, as compared with other prior periods. The Company is also requesting interim rate relief to temporarily increase its revenues by \$16,244,207, pending the Commission's decision on the Company's request for a permanent increase.

On July 7, 2026, the Commission is expected to vote on the Company's request pertaining to interim rates, which become effective on July 20, 2026. These rates provide temporary relief for the Company while the Commission processes the Company's request for permanent relief.

Effective with this billing cycle, customers in all rate classes can expect to see increases in their customer, energy, and demand charges no higher than the proposed rates as follows:
