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Gentlemen/Ladies:

This new company from other US State purchased Florida City Gas; and with the prior Gas Co. **we paid \$24 to \$28 per month just 3 years ago** and NOW this NEW company using the same name is **charging currently \$42 to \$45 per month**, my last used of GAS only was **\$14.44**, the rest is Fees and Taxes, specially a Basic Service charge **from \$12 to \$18**.

These increased in 3 years has been 60.71% or average of 20.2% per year which is in excess of the INFLATION that in 3 years has been (4.1%, 2.9%, 2.6%). We opposed this proposal.

The Gas commission / Utility Commission already granted an increase recently, this company may not recuperate their investment money from the consumers in a short period of time, their investment should be a long time capital investment.
