EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction

The purpose of this filing is to introduce a new Centrex feature called Centrex Simultaneous Ring ("SimRing") in the Florida GSST tariff.

BellSouth's SimRing is a terminating feature that allows simultaneous notification on an incoming call to a Centrex "pilot" directory number (PDN) and up to four other "non-pilot" member directory numbers (NPMDN). The PDN must be an analog (non-ISDN) Centrex station; the NPMDNs can be wireline Centrex or non-Centrex numbers, including ISDN, or wireless/cellular telephone numbers.

Calls dialed to a Centrex station (PDN) equipped with the SimRing feature will ring the Centrex PDN telephone and any valid user-defined NPMDN telephones. The first phone to answer the call connects to the calling party. The other phones stop ringing and are available for other calls. The caller doesn't know that all the SimRing froup NPMDNs have received notification of the call.

This feature will only be provided for BellSouth Centrex Service and is not available for ESSX or MultiServ customers.
