INTERROGATORIES

28. On July 18, 2022, in Docket No. 20220128-PU, FPUC (electric and gas divisions) filed a joint petition requesting the Commission's approval to establish a regulatory asset for recording what it identified as non-capitalizable costs associated with a new customer information system ("CIS") that is planned to be in-service in 2025. In its petition, the Company describes ECIS, the existing CIS in need of replacement, which will be in service beyond the end of the projected 2023 test year in the instant docket. Please identify all costs related to maintaining and servicing ECIS that are included in the historical, intermediate, and projected test years, along with the FERC account name(s) and number(s) the costs were recorded in.

Company Response:

The Company objects to portions of this request as vague, specifically the phrase "identify all costs," not defined in the instructions, and "maintaining and servicing." FPUC has made a good-faith and reasonable attempt to ascertain the meaning of such requests and provide a response based on such attempt, but FPUC responds without waiving its objection to the vagueness of the request.
