By Order No. 25772, issued February 24, 1992, the Commission proposed requiring ALLTEL and Southern Bell to implement an alternative toll plan on certain routes in Putnam County. That Order became final and effective on March 16, 1992.

On March 16, 1992, Southern Bell filed a Request for Waiver for a Portion of Order No. 25772 (Waiver Request). As a basis for its Waiver Request, Southern Bell stated it would be unable to comply with the reporting requirement that was set forth at page 7 of the Order.

Following receipt of Southern Bell's Waiver Request, Legal reviewed the recommendation and Order and discovered there was an error in the Order. Specifically, the reporting requirement set forth at page 7 of the Order was inadvertently inserted into the Order from the wrong computer document. The reporting requirement was not taken from the recommendation that the Commission had approved, but rather, was accidently moved from the wrong document.

The error appearing in Order No. 25772 has now been corrected by Amendatory Order No. 25772-A, issued April 20, 1992. As a result, no action will be needed on Southern Bell's Waiver Request. Counsel for Southern Bell has been so advised.
