RE: DOCKET NO. 921098-WS - Application for certificates to provide water and wastewater service in Alachua County under grandfather rights by TURKEY CREEK, INC. & FAMILY DINER, INC. d/b/a TURKEY CREEK UTILITIES.

Issue 1: Recommendation that the difference between the utility's current charges and those approved by the Commission on 5/4/93 should be held subject to refund pending the outcome of the hearing. Within 30 days of the date of the order issued as a result of the decision on this issue, the utility should be required to file a bond, letter of credit or escrow agreement to guarantee any potential refunds of water and/or wastewater revenues collected through the disposition of the protest. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.360(6), F.A.C., the utility should provide a report by the 20th of each month indicating the monthly and total revenue collected subject to refund. In addition, if a bond or letter of credit is chosen as security, the utility should be ordered to file a schedule supporting the amount of the bond or letter of credit, as discussed in staff's memorandum dated 7/24/93.




