

**GTE FLORIDA INCORPORATED'S
NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL) hereby gives notice of its intent to seek confidential classification of certain material produced in response to items 4 and 5 of the Commission Staff's First Request for Production of Documents in this matter. This Notice exempts this material from §119.07(1) of the Florida Statutes and §24(a), Art. 1 of the State Constitution and protects it from public disclosure. Copies of the confidential material have been provided to Staff along with this notice.

All of this information falls within Florida Statutes §364.183(3)(e), which defines the term "proprietary confidential business information" to include "information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of that information." In a competitive business, any such knowledge obtained about a competitor can be used to the detriment of the entity to which it pertains. This

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

unfair advantage skews the operation of the market, to the ultimate detriment of the consumer.

GTEFL will file a detailed request for confidential classification of the documents at issue within 21 days, as allowed by the Commission's Rules.
