3. BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., (BellSouth) has petitioned the Commission for approval of Numbering Plan Area (NPA) relief for the 904 area code. Section 282 103(1), Florida Statutes, provides:

There is created within the Division of Communications of the Department of Management Services the SUNCOM Network which shall be developed to serve as the state communications system for providing local and long-distance communications services to state agencies, political subdivisions of the state, municipalities, and nonprofit corporations pursuant to ss. 282 101-282 111.

DMS therefore has an interest in this proceeding as it may impact the SUNCOM Network and its users, thereby substantially affecting DMS' and the users' interests.

4. The interests of DMS and the SUNCOM Network are not adequately represented by any other party to this proceeding. Additionally, DMS has actively participated in industry proceedings in the past (see minutes and attendance lists attached to BellSouth's Petition) and anticipates that its participation in this docket will aid the Commission by representing the interests of SUNCOM users and, ultimately, the taxpayers of the State of Florida.
