It is proposed that the Plant Capacity Charge for water be increased from \$220 to \$828 and the system capacity charge be increased from \$320 to \$925 per Equivalent Residential Connection (ERC). It is also proposed that an AFPI charge be initiated which will be capped over a five year period. An Equivalent Residential

An Equivalent Residential Connection means (a) 350 gallons per day for water; (b) the number of gallons a utility demonstrates is the average delity flow for a single residential unit; or (c) the number of gallons which have been approved by the Department of Environmental Protection for a single residential unit. An Allowance for Funds Prudently Invested (AFPI) Charge is a mechanism, which allows a utility an opportunity to earn a tair rate of return on prudently constructed plant held for future use from the future customers to be
