25-30.060 Application for Exemption from Regulation or Nonjurisdictional Finding. 2 (1) Each application for an exemption shall be filed in 3 original and four copies, with the Director, Division of Records 4 5 and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399 0870. Sample application forms may be obtained from the 6 7 Division of Water and Wastewater, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, 8 Tallahassee, Florida 32399 0850. (2) Each application for an exemption from regulation shall 9 10 contain the following information: (a) The name of the system owner; 11 (b) The physical address of the system; 12 13 (c) The mailing address of the applicant, if different from 14 the system address; (d) The name, address, and phone number of the primary 15 16 contact person for the exemption request; (c) The nature of the applicant's business organization, 17 e.g., corporation, partnership, limited partnership, sole 18 proprietorship, association, and 19 (f) A statement that the applicant is aware that pursuant to 20 Section 837.06, Florida Statutes, whoever knowingly makes a false 21 22 statement in writing with the intent to mislead a public servant in the performance of his official duty shall be guilty of a 23 misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 24 775.082 or s. 775.083. 25

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2 exemption is being applied for and contain one of the following: 3 (a) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367,022(1), Florida 4 Statutes, a statement from the owner of the system that the system 5 is used solely to provide bottled water and that water is not provided to customers through a water main or service pipe; 6 7 (b) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(2), Florida 8 Statutes, a statement from the governmental authority specifying 9 the statutory authority for the governmental authority; that the system is owned, operated, managed, or controlled by the 10 governmental authority; and stating whether it provides water 11 service, wastewater service or both. The applicant shall describe 12 with particularity the nature of the ownership, operation, 13 management, and control of the system; 14 (c) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(3), Florida 15 Statutes, a statement from the manufacturer that service is 16 provided solely in connection with its operations; and stating 17 whether it provides water service, wastewater service or both; 18 (d) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(4), Florida 19 Statutes, a statement from the public lodging cotablishment that 20 service is provided solely in connection with service to its 21 quests, and stating whether it provides water service, wastewater 22 service or both; 23 (c) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(5), Florida 24 Statutes, a statement from the landlord that it prevides service 25

(3) Each application must specifically state which type of

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solely to tenants; that charges for service are non specifically contained in rental charges; and stating whether it provides water 3 service, wastewater service or both. A copy of the landlord's most recent version of a standard lease or rental agreement shall be 4 submitted with the application; 5 (f) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(6), Florida 6 7 Statutes, a statement from the owner of the system that the system 8 has or will have the capacity to serve 100 or fewer persons; and stating whether it provides water service, wastewater service or 9 both. The applicant shall submit documentation verifying the 10 capacity of the system(s). For a wastewater system, the capacity 11 12 of both the treatment and disposal facilities shall be documented; (g) For an exemption pursuant to section 367,022(7), Florida 13 Statutes, a statement that it provides service solely to members 14 who own and control it; and stating that it provides water service, 15 wastewater service or both. 16 1. When the applicant is a condominium formed pursuant to 17 the Condominium Act, Chapter 718, Florida Statutes, it must 18 19 provide: a. A copy of the certificate obtained from the Secretary of 20 21 State showing that it is formed under Chapter 718, Florida 22 Statutes, b. A statement as to whether the applicant's articles of 23 incorporation and bylaws contain the requirements for turnover of 24

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control of the condominium to the nondeveloper members as set out

in Chapter 718, Florida Statutes. If turnover of control has not occurred, a statement as to the date turnover of control to the 2 3 nondeveloper members is expected to occur. 2. A copy of the certificate obtained from the Secretary of State showing that it is formed under Chapter 719, Florida 8 9 Statutes: b. A statement as to whether the applicant's articles of 10 incorporation and bylaws contain the requirements for turnover of 11 control of the cooperative to the nondeveloper members as set out 12 in Chapter 719, Florida Statutes. If turnover of control has not 13 occurred, a statement as to the date turnover of control to the 14 nondeveloper members is expected to occur. 15 3. When the applicant is a nonprofit corporation formed 16 pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, it must provide: 17 a. The articles of incorporation as filed with the Secretary 18 of State and the bylaws which documents must demonstrate that it 19 provides service solely to members who own the corporation; 20 b. A description of the voting rights and their location in 21 the articles of incorporation and the bylaws. The voting rights 22 shall be one vote per unit of ownership or other voting rights if 23 the Commission finds they are fair and nondiscriminatory so that 24

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members have equitable control of the corporation.

In circumstances where the applicant is a nonprofit corporation formed by a developer pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, it must provide documentation showing that control has passed or, if not, the circumstances under which control of the corporation will pass to the nondeveloper members. The time must not exceed seven years from the date of incorporation unless the Commission finds that special circumstances justify a longer time. (h) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(8), Florida Statutes, a statement from the reseller that service is provided at a rate or charge that does not exceed the actual purchase price; stating that the reseller is aware of the requirements of Rule 25-30.111, Florida Administrative Code; stating that the reseller is aware of the requirements of Section 367.122, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25 30.262, .263, .264, .265, .266 and .267, Florida Administrative Code, relating to examination and testing of meters, and stating whether it provides water service, wastewater service or both. The reseller must also provide the name of the utility providing service to it and that utility's current rates and charges. The reseller must submit a schedule of all of its proposed rates and charges, an explanation of the proposed method of billing customers, separately, for both water and wastewater, and a schedule showing that the amount billed will not exceed the amount paid for water, wastewater, or both; (i) For an exemption pursuant to Section 367.022(9), Florida

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Statutes, a statement from the owner of the wastewater system that
