REQUEST FOR CANCELLATION OF INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE

Datalink Communications, Inc. d/b/a Datalink International, Inc. ("Datalink"), by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 25-24.474, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests that the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") cancel its interexchange certificate. In support of its request, Datalink states:

- The Commission granted Datalink Interexchange Telecommunications
 Certificate No. 4008 by Order No. PSC-95-0232-FOF-TI issued February 20, 1995.
- According to Commission staff, Datalink owes the following outstanding regulatory assessment fees:

For 1995 - \$71.00 (a \$50 regulatory assessment fee plus penalties and interest)

For 1996 - \$62.00 (a \$50 regulatory assessment fee plus penalties and interest)

For 1997 - \$50.00

Total Regulatory Assessment Fees Owed = \$183.00

A check for \$183.00 is enclosed with this Request as payment for all of Datalink's outstanding regulatory assessment fees. Datalink's utility code is TI333.

3. When Datalink applied to the Commission for interexchange certification in 1994, Datalink intended to provide prepaid debit card service in Florida. However, Datalink has never provided service in Florida, and at this time has decided not to

begin providing service in Florida. Thus, Datalink now requests that the Commission cancel Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate No. 4008.

4. Datalink does not have any customer deposits on hand and has never issued any bills. Accordingly, these issues do not need to be addressed by Datalink in connection with the cancellation of its certificate. Similarly, because Datalink does not have any customers in Florida, notice regarding discontinuation of service is unnecessary.

WHEREFORE, Datalink requests that the Commission:

- (a) cancel Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate No. 4008; and
- (b) grant such other relief as the Commission deems appropriate.
