SECTION 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Cont'd)

2.9. Operation of Telecommunications Relay Service

2.9.1. Intrastate toll calls received from the relay service will be discounted by 50 percent of the applicable rate for a voice nonrelay call except where that where either the calling or called party indicates that either party is both hearing and visually impaired, the call will be discounted 60 percent off the applicable rate for voice nonrelay call. The above discounts apply only to time-scasitive elements of a charge for the call and shall not apply to per call charges such as a credit card surcharge.

2.10. Sale of Telecomosunications Services to Uncertified IXCs Prohibited

2.10.1.Customers reselling or rebilling telecommunications services must have a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as an interexchange carrier from the Florida Public Service Commission.

2.11. Customer Deposits

2.11.1. The Company will not collect deposits from Customers.
