

REQUEST FOR CANCELLATION OF DIGITAL MEDIA PARTNERS' INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE

Digital Media Partners' ("Digital Media"), pursuant to Commission Rule 25-24.474, Florida Administrative Code, requests the cancellation of its IXC certificate No. (TBA-effective April 8, 1998), granting Digital Media to provide interexchange telecommunications service, and in support thereof states as follows:

- Digital Media hereby notifies the Florida Public Service Commission of its intent to cancel its IXC Certificate. Digital Media will pay any regulatory fees by May 1, 1998;
- 2. Time Warner, the ultimate parent company of Digital Media, is restructuring some of its affiliated companies to streamline ownership making it easier for the regulatory agencies and prospective investors to follow corporate organization and governance of Time Warner Telecom. As part of that restructuring, it was decided that the Digital Media IXC certificate was no longer necessary as Time Warner has a statewide certificate to provide telecommunications services via Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P. See attached exhibit "A."
- 3. Time Warner does not have any customers under the Digital Media certificate, therefore no further disposition of customer billing or notice is required.



4. For the reasons stated above, Digital Media Partners' respectfully request that the Commission grant its request for cancellation of its IXC certificate.

Our law firm has been advised that Time Warner, Inc., the ultimate parent company of Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P., holder of ALEC Certificate No. 3167 and IXC Certificate No. TBA has initiated plans to restructure a portion of the ownership in Time Warner Communications. Time Warner Communications intends to file with the Department of State of its intention to do business under the name Time Warner Telecom. The most significant part of this plan is to offer 20% of the company to the general public by way of an initial stock offering. The current partners will retain an ownership interest and Time Warner, Inc. will maintain its controlling interest in the company. There will be, therefore, no change in ownership of control.

This letter is provided to the Florida Public Service Commission and its staff for informational purposes. As the record will reflect, our original Application for Certification relied primarily upon the financial resources of Time Warner, Inc. Since there has been no change of ownership of control, no change of name, and no transfer of assets to another legal entity, we are of the opinion that no further action is required.
