### PETITION ON PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION

The Citizens of the State of Florida (Citizens) by and through their undersigned attorney, pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-22.029 and 22.036, Florida Administrative Code, file these objections to the action proposed by the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission), PAA Order No. PSC-98-0683-AS-WU, issued on May 18, 1998, which would increase water rates and service availability charges to initiate service, and request that they be granted a formal hearing in the above docket and state:

- 1. The Citizens include water customers of Lake Utility Services, Inc. (the utility), and include individuals and entities which may in due course obtain water service from the utility.
- 2. The Citizens who here petition are represented by the Office of the Public Counsel (Citizens or Petitioner) whose address is 111 W. Madison St., Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-1400.
- 3. The name and address of the agency affected and the agency's file number:

4. Petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision in its Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-98-0683-AS-WU to the extent the Order proposes to grant an increase in water rates and service availability charges imposed for the initiation of service.

- 5. The Citizens dispute the following material facts:
  - a. The rate base advocated by Commission Staff and accepted by the utility is excessive;
  - b. The return on equity and the overall rate of return to which the Commission Staff and the utility have agreed are excessive;
  - c. The revenue requirement advocated by Commission Staff and accepted by the utility is excessive;
  - d. The service availability fees to which the Commission Staff and the utility have agreed are excessive.
- 6. More specifically, the Petitioner cannot state at this time the ultimate facts that will support its positions in this docket. However, based upon the Petitioner's current understanding of the facts, it is alleged that the rate increase approved in PAA Order No. PSC-98-0683-AS-WU is excessive and unjustified because:

### Rate Base

- a. Utility plant in service is overstated;
- b. The amount of contributions in aid of construction is understated;
- c. Utility has over collected allowance for funds prudently invested, and such over collection should be aded to CIAC;
- d. Used and useful is overstated;
- e. Accumulated depreciation balance is understated;
- f. Rate base is overstated;

### Capital Structure

- g. While the Petitioner accepts the use of the Commission's most current leverage formula the utility's return on equity should be lowered because of the utility's poor quality of service.
- h. Overall cost of capital is overstated;
- i. The utility did not utilize a proper and representative capital structure;

# Revenue Requirement

j. The revenue requirement is excessive;

# Service Availability Charges

k. The service availability charges are excessive.

### Quality of Service

- 1. Utility provides poor quality of service;
- 7. Each of the foregoing matters involve disputed issues of material fact.
- 8. The Citizens are entitled to relief under Section 367.081, Florida Statutes, which provides in substance that the Commission must approve only those rates and charges which reflect a fair return upon a utility's investment in property used and useful in providing service to the public.
- 9. Order No. PSC-98-0683-AS-WU establishes June 8, 1998, as the date by which protests must be filed.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner protests PAA Order No. PSC-98-0683-AS-WU and petitions the Florida Public Service Commission for a formal evidentiary hearing under the provisions of Section

120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and further petitions that such hearing be scheduled at a convenient time within or as close as practical to the utility's certificated service area.
