The Commission, at the November 3, 1998 agenda, voted to deny staffs recommendation which was originally filed on September 10, 1998. Staff had recommended that the case be dismissed. The Commission instead voted to deny staff and proceed to hearing as expeditiously as possible. The Commission was informed at the agenda that the eight month clock would expire before a final vote could be taken on the rate request.

This memorandum has been written to officially inform you that the eight months will indeed be exceeded for this case. In fact the eight months will expire on February 8, 1999. Staff has obtained the nearest available hearing dates that will allow all parties to present prefiled testimony on the overearnings situation of this company. The hearings are currently scheduled for March 10-11, 1999. The current schedule will place the final vote on this case on June 1, 1999, which will occur prior to the twelve months expiring on June 8, 1999.
