Issue 1: With Northeast's election of price regulation effective February 9, 1999, as of what date should its rates be capped?

Recommendation: With Northeast's election of price regulation effective February 9, 1999, its basic local telecommunications service rates should be capped effective February 9, 1999, pursuant to Section 364.051(2)(b), Florida Statutes. The rates for protected non-basic services should be capped at the rates in effect on July 1, 1995, pursuant to Section 364.051(6)(a)(2), Florida Statutes. Network access services should be capped effective February 9, 1999, pursuant to Section 364.163(1), Florida Statutes.

Issue 2: Should Northeast's proposed tariff filing to introduce Customized Code Restriction with Personal Identification Number, Six-Way Calling, Caller ID with Call Waiting, and Anonymous Call Rejection be approved effective April 1, 1999?

Recommendation: Yes. Northeast's proposed tariff filing to introduce Customized Code Restriction with Personal Identification Number, Six-Way Calling, Caller ID with Call Waiting, and Anonymous Call Rejection should be approved effective April 1, 1999.

APPROVED

Issue 3: Should these dockets be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. With the Commission's approval of staff's recommendation in Issue 1, Docket No. 990152-TL should be closed. If, after reviewing the company's prior period earnings, the staff believes Northeast experienced overearnings, then staff will open a new docket. With the Commission's approval of staff's recommendation in Issue 2, the tariff should become effective on April 1, 1999. If a protest is filed within 21 days from the issuance date of the Order, the tariff should remain in effect with any revenues held subject to refund, pending resolution of the protest. If no timely protest is filed, Docket 990126-TL should also be closed.
