The Commission's Division of Administration provided me a copy of your 1997 regulatory assessment fee (RAF) return form with your note that you "never installed, contracted, or used a public pay telephone. Previously requested that the license be canceled as it was never activated." Your form was dated 2/5/99.

On January 26, 1999, the Commission issued Order No. PSC-99-0160-FOF-TC, which imposed a \$500 fine for nonpayment of the 1997 RAFs. The Order states, in part, "Under Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, certificate holders must pay a minimum annual regulatory assessment fee of \$50 if the certificate was active during any portion of the calendar year." A certificate is considered active until the company notifies the Commission in writing that it wishes to cancel its certificate.

You stated on the form that you had previously requested that your certificate be canceled. However, we have no record of receiving your request. Please provide me with a copy of your letter. If your letter is dated in 1997, your company will still owe the minimum 1997 RAFs, plus statutory penalty and interest charges, which, if paid in March 1999, totals \$70.00. If your letter is
