Enclosed, please find an original and two (2) copies of first revised sheets to Broadslate's Price List No. 1. Specifically, Broadslate has made a business decision to discontinue providing its services in St. Petersburg and Tampa, Florida, effective March 17, 2001. Although Broadslate will no longer be providing its services in these markets, Broadslate's services will continue to be available in Clearwater and Jacksonville, Florida.

Broadslate is a business-class Internet service provider utilizing SDSL technology over an unbundled local loop. Broadslate does not provide any dial tone or voice services. Therefore, Broadslate's decision to withdraw from St. Petersburg and Tampa, Florida should have no direct impact on a consumer's ability to receive voice services, including access to emergency or 911 service.

In the process of making this decision, we have identified approximately fifty (50) consumers who have expressed an interest in subscribing to Broadslate's service where service has not yet been installed. For these interested consumers, Broadslate will make available and provide a list of other competitive (alternative) service providers. Additionally, we have identified two (2) consumers where service has been installed. For these Broadslate customers, we will provide a list of other competitive (alternative) service providers and take whatever steps are necessary to facilitate a customer transfer from Broadslate to the new service provider with minimal or no interruption in service. Broadslate is currently working with the incumbent local exchange carrier serving these areas in an effort to complete the customer transfers. Broadslate's service for these two (2) customers shall remain in effect until May 17, 2001, or until the customer transfer is completed, whichever occurs sooner.
