ORDER APPROVING INTERIM TRAFFIC
TERMINATION AND BILLING AGREEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 28, 2001, Smart City Telecommunications L.L.C.
d/b/a Smart City Telecom (f/k/a Vista-United Telecommunications)
(Smart City) and Adelpia Business Solutions Investment, LLC
(Adelpia Business Solutions) filed a request for approval of an
interim traffic and billing agreement pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(e)
of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). The agreement is
incorporated by reference herein. A copy of the agreement may be
obtained by contacting our Division of Records and Reporting.

The Act encourages parties to enter into negotiated
agreements. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e),
negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for
approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or
approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall
be deemed approved.

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This agreement covers a two-year period and governs the relationship between the companies exchange of local traffic and toll traffic pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 251. Under 47 U.S.C. § 252(a)(1), the agreement shall include a detailed schedule of itemized charges for interim traffic and billing and each service or network element included in the agreement.

Upon review of the proposed agreement, we believe that it complies with the Act; thus, we hereby approve it. Smart City and Adelphia Business Solutions are also required to file any subsequent supplements or modifications to their agreement with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the interim traffic and billing agreement between Smart City Telecommunications L.L.C. d/b/a Smart City Telecom (f/k/a Vista-United Telecommunications and Adelphia Business Solutions Investment, LLC, is incorporated by reference in this Order, and is hereby approved. A copy of the agreement may be obtained as specified in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that any supplements or modifications to this agreement must be filed with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). It is further

ORDERED that this Docket shall be closed.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review in Federal district court pursuant to the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(6).
