Dear Mr. Rynning:

On May 8, 2001, the Commission received payment for the past due penalty and interest charges, along with a settlement proposal for \$50. Unfortunately, I will not be able to recommend acceptance of your settlement proposal since the amount you offered is not consistent with prior Commission decisions. In other similar cases, the Commission has accepted settlement amounts between \$100 and \$500.

This means you have two options. One option is to modify your previous settlement offer by increasing the settlement amount. If you choose this option, you also need to state that all other elements in your original settlement proposal remain in effect.

The other option would be to keep your settlement proposal at \$50. If you choose this option, staff would file a recommendation to deny the settlement offer. The Commissioners would then decide whether to approve or deny staff's recommendation. You would be welcome to participate at the Agenda Conference when the Commissioners voted on your docket.
