RE: Docket No. 990374-WS; Application for Certificates to Operate a Water and Wastewater Utility in Highlands County by The Woodlands of Lake Placid, L.P.

Dear Mr. Jackson:

The Application referenced above continues to be deficient as a result of errors contained in The Woodlands of Lake Placid, L.P.'s (Woodlands) notice of January 20, 2001. In additional, as you are aware, there is an overlap of your proposed wastewater territory with Highlands Utilities Corporation's (Highlands) existing territory that must be resolved. The following filing requirement and request for additional information must be completed in order for our review of your application to be completed.

Pursuant to Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, the utility must provide notice of the application to the governing body of the county or city affected to the Public Counsel, to the commission, and to the customers of the system to be certificated or deleted. Specifically, the notice of January 20, 2001, contained an incorrect legal description and referred to an application for water instead of wastewater. Therefore, the notice and legal description will need to be corrected and republished.

In addition, the issue of the overlap of your proposed wastewater territory with Highlands' territory will need to be resolved. One alternative is to obtain an agreement which allows Woodlands to provide notice to delete the overlapping service territory from Highlands' approved territory and that Woodlands can serve the wastewater territory. The agreement should include description and map of the overlapping area. If such agreement is obtained and provided to the Commission, the deletion of that territory from Highlands' service territory can be accomplished in this docket, rather than in another separate proceeding. If you intend to pursue this alternative please provide the Commission with a copy of the agreement before you begin to notice.

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A copy of the Highlands County list of entities that must be noticed is enclosed. Please note that the list is only valid until July 21, 2001. The notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory proposed to be served. Also enclosed is a proposed notice of wastewater application and territory description, including the proposed deletion language to correct the overlap of territory with Highlands. Please verify that the language in the notice and legal description is correct. After the wastewater territory noticing is complete, you must provide affidavits indicating that you have completed the noticing.

In addition, please be aware that staff is considering recommending a change from flat rates to metered monthly service rates which would be billed to all customers. In order to develop metered rates, individual customer water usage data will be needed. Therefore, staff requests that the utility start reading the individual meters that have been installed on a monthly basis. We also suggest that the utility continue meter installation on currently unmetered properties.

Please file an original and five copies of the requested information relating to deficiencies no later than July 13, 2001 with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850.
