Enclosed please find a check in the amount of \$67.56 which covers our past due amount and interest on our Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF). Our Company made an error in calculating our RAF fees. We currently pay another state's fee at the same time and made a mistake with the Florida calculation. The Florida calculation has a minimum requirement of \$50.00. We sent in only the amount that was calculated. We have implemented a review process of all state fees before being signed and mailed out. The state fees will be double checked by our CFO.

We would like the Commission to consider this mistake a one time error on our part and allow our certificate to remain active. Dear Mr. Cumberbatch:

A docket has been opened by staff of the Florida Public Service Commission for nonpayment of the full amount due of the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF), which was due January 30, 2001, plus statutory penalty and interest charges. Commission records show that Publicall Telecommunications Inc. paid \$6.94 of the \$50.00 minimum on February 14, 2001.

It is staff's intention to file a recommendation imposing a \$500 fine for this rule violation, or cancelling your telecommunications certificate. The Commissioners will vote at an upcoming Agenda Conference whether or not to accept staff's recommendation. A Proposed Agency Action Order will then be issued within 20 days after the vote and your company will have 21 days to protest the Order. It should be noted that just paying the delinquent RAF amount will not prevent your certificate from being cancelled.

If the Order is not protested and the past due amount, including statutory penalty and interest charges, is not paid, then your certificate will be cancelled, and the past due amount will be turned over to the Florida Comptroller's Office for further collection attempts. Therefore, it is important that you contact staff as soon as possible, but no later than June 5, 2001, to discuss your options.
