RE: DOCKET NO. 010134-TX - Initiation of show cause proceedings against Network Multi-Family Security Corporation d/b/a Priority Link for apparent violation of Section 364.183(1), F.S., Access to Company Records.

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by Network Multi-Family Security Corporation d/b/a Priority Link to resolve the apparent violation of Section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes, Access to Company Records?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should accept the company's settlement proposal. Any contribution should be received by the Commission within ten business days from the issuance date of the Commission Order and should identify the docket number and company name. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund. If the company fails to pay in accordance with the terms of the Commission Order, Certificate Number 4761 should be canceled administratively.
