## **SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION**

DSLnet Communications, LLC ("DSLnet"), through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests authority to discontinue service in selected areas defined herein. Pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, DSLnet offers the following information:

#### 1. Name and address of carrier

DSLnet Communications, LLC 545 Long Wharf Drive, Fifth Floor New Haven, CT 06511

# 2. Date of planned service discontinuance

DSLnet proposes to discontinue service on August 31, 2001 in the selected markets described in paragraph 3 below.

## 3. Points of geographic areas of service affected

DSLnet proposes to discontinue services described herein in certain markets in the following states: Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Idaho, Kansas, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Texas.

# 4. Brief description of the type of service affected

DSLnet proposes to discontinue provision of its interstate special access DSL service, which is used for high-speed internet access.

# 5. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers

DSLnet provided written customer notice on July 17, 2001, in accordance with the requirements of Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules. In addition to the information required by Rule 63.71, the notice explained that DSLnet is striving to identify alternative providers that would be able to provide comparable service in a manner that would avoid or at least minimize service disruption and inconvenience.

# 6. Non-dominance of the carrier with respect to the service to be discontinued

DSLnet is non-dominant with respect to the interstate special access services that it proposes to discontinue.

# 7. Other Information Pursuant to Rule 63.71(b)(5)

As the proposed service to be discontinued is interstate in nature pursuant to *GTE Telephone Operating Cos.*, *GTOC Tariff No. 1, Trans. No. 1148*, 13 FCC Red. 22,466 (1998), DSLnet has not sought approval for the proposed discontinuation of service from any state utility commission. However, DSLnet has served a copy of this application on the state utility commissions of every state with affected customers in order to apprise them of DSLnet's efforts to assist in the identification of and migration to alternative providers that would be able to provide comparable service in a manner that would avoid or at least minimize service disruption and inconvenience. DSLnet is making all reasonable efforts to coordinate these efforts, and DSLnet will cooperate fully with migration of affected service to other carriers. It should be

noted that DSLnet does not propose to discontinue the provision of any intrastate service and does not seek to cancel or amend any existing state or federal license or tariff.

# 8. Service

In accordance with FCC Rules 63.71 and 63.90(d) and (e), DSLnet has mailed a copy of this application to the Governor and State Commission (as defined by the Communications Act of 1934) of each of the states listed in paragraph 3 above, and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense.
