Telecom of Florida, Inc.

By letter dated June 20, 2001, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") filed a request for approval of adoption of the interconnection, unbundling, resale and collocation agreement entered into between BellSouth and Intermedia Communications, Inc. submitted to the Commission on October 4, 2000, which went into effect by operation of law. Allegiance Telecom of Florida, Inc. ("Allegiance") is adopting the interconnection, unbundling, resale and collocation agreement and all amendments approved by the Commission in its entirety pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on September 12, 2001. The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.16 of the Administrative Procedures Manual in that it complies with Section 252(i) of the Act. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
