NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER CANCELING INTEREXCHANGE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service
Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in
nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are
substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding,
pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Urban Media of Florida, Inc. (Urban Media of Florida), holder
of Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate (IXC) of Public
Convenience and Necessity No. 7536 and Alternative Local Exchange
Telecommunications Certificate (ALEC) of Public Convenience and
Necessity No. 7498, has requested the cancellation of IXC
Certificate No. 7536 and ALEC Certificate No. 7498. Urban Media of
Florida has complied with the provisions of Rule 25-24.474(2) and
Rule 25-24.820(2), Florida Administrative Code, by providing

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adequate notice in writing of its request for cancellation of its IXC and ALEC certificates and by submitting its Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) for the year 2000. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel IXC Certificate No. 7536 and ALEC Certificate No. 7498, effective June 18, 2001. The Commission is vested with jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Sections 364.335 and 364.337, Florida Statutes.

In addition, under Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, certificate holders must pay a minimum annual RAF of \$50 if the certificate was active during any portion of the calendar year. A RAFs Return notice for the year 2001 will be mailed to Urban Media of Florida. Neither the cancellation of its certificate nor the failure to receive a RAFs Return notice for the year 2001 shall relieve Urban Media of Florida from its obligation to pay RAFs for the year 2001.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Urban Media of Florida, Inc.'s Certificate No. 7536 to provide Interexchange Telecommunications services is hereby canceled, effective June 18, 2001. It is further

ORDERED that Urban Media of Florida, Inc.'s Certificate No. 7498 to provide Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications services is hereby canceled, effective June 18, 2001. It is further


ORDERED that Urban Media of Florida, Inc. shall remit Regulatory Assessment Fees for the year 2001. It is further

ORDERED that the provisions of this Order, issued as proposed agency action, shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order unless an appropriate petition, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, is received by the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on the date set forth in the "Notice of Further Proceedings" attached hereto. It is further

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ORDERED that in the event this Order becomes final, this docket shall be closed.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing that is available under Section 120.57, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

The action proposed herein is preliminary in nature. Any person whose substantial interests are affected by the action proposed by this order may file a petition for a formal proceeding, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative

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Code. This petition must be received by the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on October 29, 2001.

In the absence of such a petition, this order shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order.

Any objection or protest filed in this docket before the issuance date of this order is considered abandoned unless it satisfies the foregoing conditions and is renewed within the specified protest period.
