ISSUE 1: Should the Commission issue an order granting Verizon's Motion and directing that GNAPS sign, without modification or comment, the conforming Interconnection Agreement prepared pursuant to the arbitration proceedings in this Docket?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should issue an order granting Verizon's Motion and directing that GNAPS sign, without modification or comment, the conforming Interconnection Agreement prepared pursuant to the arbitration proceedings in this Docket. If the parties do not file a conforming signed and unmodified agreement within 10 calendar days of the effective date of the order flowing from this recommendation, staff recommends the existing agreement under which the parties have continued to operate be deemed terminated, and declared null and void after the close of business on the 11th day following the effective date of the aforesaid order.


