PETITION FOR FORMAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING TO MODIFY DATE OF CANCELLATION OF CERTIFICATE

Petitioners, Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc., MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., and Access Network Services, Inc. (hereinafter "Petitioners") pursuant to Section 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, Rule 25-22.029(3), Florida Administrative Code and Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, hereby file this petition for formal administrative hearing to challenge the decision of the Florida Public Service Commission (hereinafter the "Commission") to cancel AAV/CLEC Certificate No. 3151, issued to Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc., AAV/CLEC Certificate No. 4040, issued to MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., and STS Certificate No. 1669 issued to Access Network Services, Inc. with an effective date of January 2, 2004. In support of this Petition, the Petitioners state:

1. The agency affected by this proceeding is the Florida Public Service Commission.

The Commission docket identification numbers are 031053-TA (AAV/CLEC Certificate No.

The Commission is an agency of the State of Florida, and has been granted exclusive regulatory jurisdiction over telecommunications companies operating in the state of Florida in accordance with Chapters 350 and 364, Florida Statutes, and rules promulgated thereunder. As such, the Commission is the appropriate entity upon which this challenge is to be filed.
- 2. a. Petitioner, Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. (hereinafter "Metropolitan"), is a Delaware Corporation, doing business in Florida, whose principal office in Florida is located at 325 John Knox Road, Suite 105, Tallahassee, FL 32303-4131. Metropolitan is a competitive local exchange telecommunications company certificated by the Commission to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Florida. Metropolitan's representatives are Floyd R. Self and E. Gary Early, Messer, Caparello & Self, P.A., 215 South Monroe Street, Suite 701, Tallahassee, Florida 32301, telephone (850) 222-0720, who shall be Metropolitan's representatives for service purposes during the course of this proceeding.
- b. Petitioner, MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., (hereinafter "MCI WorldCom") is a Delaware Corporation, doing business in Florida, whose principal office in Florida is located at 325 John Knox Road, Suite 105, Tallahassee, FL 32303-4131. MCI WorldCom is a competitive local exchange telecommunications company certificated by the Commission to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Florida. MCI WorldCom's representatives are Floyd R. Self and E. Gary Early, Messer, Caparello & Self, P.A., 215 South Monroe Street, Suite 701, Tallahassee, Florida 32301, telephone (850) 222-0720, who shall be MCI WorldCom's representatives for service purposes during the course of this proceeding.

- c. Petitioner, Access Network Services, Inc., (hereinafter "Access") is a Texas Corporation, doing business in Florida, whose principal office in Florida is located at 325 John Knox Road, Suite 105, Tallahassee, FL 32303-4131. Access is certificated by the Commission to provide shared tenant services in Florida. Accesses' representatives are Floyd R. Self and E. Gary Early, Messer, Caparello & Self, P.A., 215 South Monroe Street, Suite 701, Tallahassee, Florida 32301, telephone (850) 222-0720, who shall be Accesses' representatives for service purposes during the course of this proceeding.
- d. Petitioner's substantial interests are adversely affected by the cancellation of the subject certificates with an effective date of January 2, 2004, due to the fact that cancellation on that date will adversely affect the ability of the Petitioners to effectuate the implementation of the plan of reorganization as set forth in greater detail herein.
- 3. Petitioners received notice of the cancellation of the subject certificates by no earlier than the December 22, 2003 date of the order, No. PSC-03-1460-PAA-TP. The order itself provides that any petition challenging the terms of the order must be filed with the Commission by no later than the close of business (5:00 p.m.) on January 12, 2004. A copy of the order is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. This petition is timely filed.
- 4. Petitioners initially identify the following disputed issues of material fact as set forth in the notice of proposed agency action, and reserve the right to supplement as additional facts become known to them:
- a. 1. Petitioners dispute that, given the circumstances, the subject certificates should be cancelled effective January 2, 2004. The letter upon which the cancellation is based advised the Commission that WorldCom, Inc.'s Plan of Reorganization under Chapter 11 of the Federal Bankruptcy Code had been confirmed by the bankruptcy judge. The approval of the

Plan allowed the parties to proceed with the reorganization with the ultimate goal of implementation of the plan, reorganization of the companies with MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC (hereinafter "MCImetro") and emergence of the Petitioners from bankruptcy. During discussions with Commission Staff, Staff requested that the Petitioners select a date certain for the cancellation, rather than a contingent time of effectiveness. Although, due to the nature of the proceeding, it was unclear as to when the final emergence from bankruptcy would occur, Petitioners agreed that January 2, 2004 was a reasonable date to expect the reorganization to become effective and the bankruptcy proceeding to conclude.

- 2. Due to a change in circumstances that was not within the reasonable control of the Petitioners, the reorganization of the Petitioners into MCImetro has not yet been completed. The Petitioners anticipate that the reorganization will be completed within a short period. Until the reorganization ids completed, cancellation of the certificates will cause disruption of the implementation of the Plan of Reorganization.
- b. The notice of proposed agency action provides, as a basis for cancellation of the certificates, that the Petitioners "had not paid the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs). Also, accrued statutory penalties and interest charges for late RAFs payments for the 2002 had not been paid."
- 1. Petitioner, Metropolitan, disputes that it failed to pay the 2002 RAF. Records maintained by Metropolitan indicate that it paid the RAF for the entire period from January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002. Copies of the Commission RAF Return for the period of 01/01/02 through 06/30/02, and the period of 07/01/02 through 12/31/02, and the checks reflecting payment are attached hereto as Composite Exhibit 1. Based on the Metropolitan records reflecting payment, Metropolitan disputes that it failed to pay its 2002

RAF, and disputes that it was subject to any statutory penalties or interest charges arising from the 2002 RAFs.

- 2. Petitioner, MCI WorldCom, disputes that it failed to pay the 2002 RAF. Records maintained by MCI WorldCom indicate that it paid the RAF for the entire period from January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002. Copies of the Commission RAF Return for the period of 01/01/02 through 06/30/02, and the period of 07/01/02 through 12/31/02, and the checks reflecting payment are attached hereto as Composite Exhibit 2. Based on the MCI WorldCom records reflecting payment, MCI WorldCom disputes that it failed to pay its 2002 RAF, and disputes that it was subject to any statutory penalties or interest charges arising from the 2002 RAFs.
- 3. Petitioner, Access, disputes that it failed to pay the 2002 RAF. Records maintained by Access indicate that it paid the RAF for the entire period from January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002. Copies of the Commission RAF Return for the period of 01/01/02 through 06/30/02, and the period of 07/01/02 through 12/31/02, and the checks reflecting payment are attached hereto as Composite Exhibit 3. Based on the Access records reflecting payment, Access disputes that it failed to pay its 2002 RAF, and disputes that it was subject to any statutory penalties or interest charges arising from the 2002 RAFs.
- 5. Petitioners allege the following ultimate facts that warrant a modification of the date of cancellation of the certificates:
- a. As set forth in paragraph 4.a. above, a change in circumstances has resulted in a modest delay in the reorganization of Petitioners into MCImetro. Petitioners state that it is in the interest of all parties to the bankruptcy proceeding to allow the certificates to remain viable until the reorganization is complete and the Petitioners emerge from the bankruptcy proceeding.

Since the Petitioner customer bases and operations are to be consolidated with those of MCImetro, it is in the interest of MCImetro and its ability to ensure that the needs of the customers are met to allow the certificates to remain viable until the consolidation is complete. Finally, the Petitioners allege that there will be no injury to public health, safety and welfare by allowing the certificates to remain viable until such time as the customer bases and operations of the Petitioners are fully consolidated with MCImetro. To the contrary, allowing the unimpeded consolidation of Petitioners into the MCImetro corporate legal structure will advance the interests of achieving operating efficiencies, cost savings and administrative benefits as set forth in the initial request filed in this docket, all of which serve the interests of the Commission in protecting public health, safety and welfare.

- b. As set forth in paragraph 4.b. above, the 2002 RAFs were paid by Petitioners. Therefore, to the extent that the cancellation of the certificates was based upon nonpayment of those RAFs, the Petitioners are entitled to the relief requested herein.
- 6. Petitioners contend that the following statutes and rules allow for the modification of the Commission's proposed agency action as requested in paragraph 7 herein:
 - a. Sections 364.01 and 364.335, .336, .337, and .339 Florida Statutes
 - b. Rule 25-24, Part XII, Florida Administrative Code
 - c. Rule 25-24, Part XIV, Florida Administrative Code
 - d. Rule 25-24, Part XV, Florida Administrative Code
 - e. Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code
- 7. Petitioners request that the Commission modify the effective date of the cancellation of AAV/CLEC Certificate No. 3151, issued to Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc., AAV/CLEC Certificate No. 4040, issued to MCI WorldCom Communications,

Inc., and STS Certificate No. 1669 issued to Access Network Services, Inc. to allow those certificates to remain viable until five (5) days after the Petitioners notify the Commission, in writing, that the plan of reorganization has been implemented though the consolidation of the Petitioners' customer bases and operations into MCImetro. Petitioners represent to the Commission that such notification will occur within five (5) business days of the consolidation described herein. Petitioners further request the entry of final orders finding that Petitioners have paid all applicable Regulatory Assessment Fees, including those for 2002. Since the cancellation of the subject certificates affects Petitioners' substantial interests, they are entitled to this relief by Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF ALTERNATE ACCESS VENDOR/COMPETITIVE LOCAL EXCHANGE AND SHARED TENANT SERVICE CERTIFICATES DUE TO CHAPTER 11 BANKRUPTCY

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

The Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services advised our staff that the entities listed below had not paid the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs). Also, accrued statutory penalties and interest charges for late RAFs payments for the 2002 had not been paid.

Pursuant to Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, certificate holders must pay a minimum annual RAF of \$50 if the certificate was active during any portion of the calendar year. Pursuant to Rule 25-4.0161 (2), Florida Administrative Code, the form and applicable fees are due to the Florida Public Service Commission by January 30 of the subsequent year. All entities that apply for certification receive a copy of our rules governing Alternate Access Vendor/Competitive Local Exchange and Shared Tenant service.

Due to the Plan of Reorganization under title 11 of chapter 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), Case No. 02-13533(AJG), having been filed with the Bankruptcy Court by WorldCom, Inc. and approved by said Bankruptcy Court on October 31, 2003, the certificates listed herein have been requested to be cancelled.

Chapter 11 of Section 109 of the Federal Bankruptcy Code provides for reorganization by business entities. The filing of a bankruptcy petition under Chapter 11 invokes an automatic injunction known as the Automatic Stay, codified in Bankruptcy Code Section 362. Section 362(b)(5) provides that, for governments, the filing of the petition does not operate as a stay "of the enforcement of a judgment, other than a money judgment, obtained in an actual proceeding by a governmental unit to enforce such governmental unit's police or regulatory power." (emphasis added) Thus, it would appear that we are not enjoined from exercising our police powers to protect public health, safety and welfare, but are enjoined from exercising our regulatory authority seeking to collect a debt. However, in this case, each of the entities has requested cancellation of its respective certificate. Under those circumstances, this Commission is free to do so. We note that the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services will be notified that the past due RAFs should not be sent to the Comptroller's Office for collection, but that permission for the Commission to write-off the uncollectible amounts should be requested.

Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel the certificates listed below, effective on the dates shown. If an entity's certificate is canceled in accordance with this Order, that entity shall immediately cease and desist providing Alternate Access Vendor/Competitive Local Exchange and Shared Tenant services in Florida. We are vested with juri-sdiction over this matter pursuant to Sections 364.336, 364.285, and 364.335, Florida Statutes.
