Applicant: the Colinas Group, Inc.

The Department has reviewed the application by the Colinas Group, Inc, to obtain a certificate to provide water service in Polk County for consistency with the Polk County Comprehensive Plan. The Department finds the application consistent with the Polk County Comprehensive Plan.

On February 7, 2003, the 9th Circuit Court appointed the Colinas Group, Inc., a Florida Corporation, as receiver for the Lazy S Utility Company. The Lazy S Utility Company has been in service since 1960 (Cira). Currently the Utility serves 115 customers on a 142± acre parcel. Water is provided by the City of Lakeland to the Utility through a master meter. The parcel is located in Polk County, Florida and is adjacent to the City of Lakeland, Florida, to the east and south of the parcel. The Colinas Group, Inc. proposes to operate the Utility and requires certification by the Public Service Commission to charge the existing customers the rates for service established by the 9th Circuit Court.

The parcel is in the Residential-Low Future Land Use Map classification of the Polk County Comprehensive Plan, which allows a residential density of four (4) dwelling units (du) per acre (115 du / 142 acres = .8 du per acre). Policy 2.119-A3 of the Polk County Comprehensive Plan describes housing types that conform to residential structure criteria, which include mobile homes.
