Our law firm represents Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. ("Time Warner"). On February 25, 2004, Time Warner submitted its responses to the Data Request Regarding Implementation of Requirements Arising From Federal Communication Commission's Triennial Unbundled Network Element Review High-Capacity Loops and Transport Data Request. 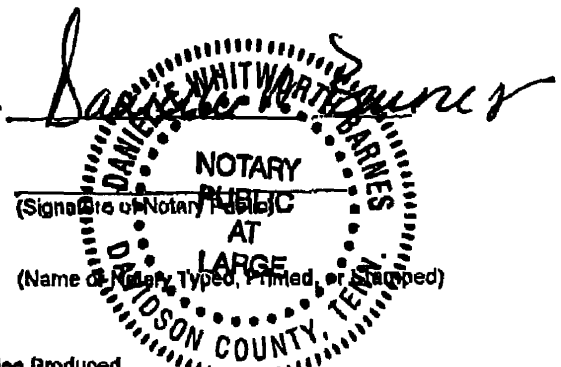
