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## Gary J. Ball Late-Filed Deposition Exhibit 1

**Reference**: Ball Deposition, Tr. 53

**Request:** Provide TRO support for the contention that a qualifying wholesale

provider must be able to provide service in a commercially reasonable

time frame. Ball Revised Direct, p. 35, lines 22-23.

**Response:** The competitive wholesale facilities triggers are intended to identify

situations where a requesting carrier can obtain alternative facilities from at least two wholesale providers ready, willing and able to provide wholesale service at the specified capacity level. The TRO describes the availability of wholesale service in terms that require it to be available in commercially reasonable time periods. Citations include the following:

#### Wholesale loops:

¶ 337. "Where competitive LECs have two alternative choices (apart from the incumbent LEC's network) to purchase wholesale high-capacity loops ... we conclude that impairment does not exist at that location for that type of high-capacity loop."

¶ 338. "[T]here should be some reasonable expectation that [the wholesale providers] are operationally capable of continuing to provide wholesale loop capacity to that customer location."

#### Wholesale transport:

¶ 400. "[W]e find that competing carriers are not impaired where competing carriers have available two or more alternative transport providers ... immediately capable and willing to provide transport at a specific capacity along a given route between incumbent LEC switches or wire centers."

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- ¶ 412. The wholesale transport test "ensures that transport can readily be obtained from a firm using facilities that are not provided by the incumbent LEC."
- ¶ 414. The wholesale transport providers "must be operationally ready and willing to provide the particular capacity transport on a wholesale basis along the specific route."
- ¶ 414. The competitive wholesale facilities trigger "safeguards against counting alternative fiber providers that ... are otherwise unable immediately to provision service along the route."
- ¶ 414, fn. 1279. "The wholesale trigger counts only wholesale offerings that are readily available."
- ¶ 415. "The key principle [in the competitive wholesale facilities trigger] is that [the wholesale providers] are currently offering and are able to provide service."
- 47 C.F.R. § 51.319(e)(1)(ii)(B). "The competing provider is willing immediately to provide, on a widely available basis, dedicated DS1 transport along a particular route."
