Pursuant to our prior commitment, I am providing to you and all other parties to this proceeding our status report of activities concerning the transfer of the water and sewer plants from Zellwood Station Cooperative to Orange County for the month of March. The following events took place during the month of March:

- (1) Zellwood Station Cooperative continues negotiation of the one additional easement which was determined to be necessary to the deal with Orange County. Progress is being made to finalize the easement.
- (2) Orange County and the St. Johns River Water Management District continue to work to resolve outstanding points of contention in the draft Consumptive Use Technical Staff Report issued by St. Johns.
- (3) The closing date on the sale of the water and wastewater facilities to Orange County has been extended by mutual agreement to occur on or before May 21, 2004. A copy of the extension agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

#### SECOND ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AGREEMENT

#### TO EXTEND CLOSING DATE

#### ORANGE COUNTY/ZELLWOOD STATION CO-OP, INC.

THIS ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AGREEMENT, by and between ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision and charter county of the State of Florida (hereinafter called "Orange County"), and Zellwood Station Co-Op, Inc., a Florida corporation (hereinafter called "the Co-Op"), is based on the following premises and constitutes an extension of that certain agreement entered into by and between the parties, Orange County and the Co-Op, entitled "Orange County/Zellwood Station Co-Op, Inc. Water & Wastewater Systems Asset Purchase & Sale Agreement", dated June 3, 2003, (hereinafter "Purchase and Sale Agreement").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the Purchase and Sale Agreement which provided for a closing on or before January 15, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Acknowledgment and Agreement to Extend Closing Date Orange County/Zellwood Station Co-Op, Inc., which provided for an extension of the closing date until on or before February 20, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Purchase and Sale Agreement included several contingencies which need to be fulfilled prior to closing and the parties wish to extend the closing of this transaction until on or before May 21, 2004, to address these contingencies.

WHEREAS, except as specifically amended by Paragraph 2 of this Extension, all other terms and conditions of the Purchase and Sale Agreement remain in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it agreed by and between Orange County and the Co-Op agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Premises Correct.</u> Each and all of the foregoing premises are true and correct representations of the facts requiring the extension of the closing date, and said premises are incorporated into this agreement.
- 2. <u>Closing Date.</u> The closing date specified in the Purchase and Sale Agreement is hereby extended to provide for a closing on or before May 21, 2004; provided specifically that

the parties agree that the County shall be entitled to a minimum of ten (10) working days to review the revised title insurance commitment, closing documents, and the Consumptive Use Permit from the St. Johns River Water Management District before the County shall be required to close this transaction.

ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

3. All Other Contract Provisions Ratified. Other than the extension of the closing date modified in paragraph 2 above, all other provisions of the Purchase and Sale Agreement are ratified and are not altered by this Acknowledgment and Agreement.
