# BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On May 3, 2004, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed its Response to the Florida Public Telecommunications Association's First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-39) and First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-30) in this docket. BellSouth's response to Interrogatory No. 9 and Request for Production Nos. 2 and 9 includes confidential business information that is considered proprietary to BellSouth. In addition, on May 3, 2004 BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06 (3)(a), BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification with respect to Interrogatory No. 9 and Request for Production No. 9. Interrogatory No. 9 and certain documents produced in response to Request for Production No. 9 relate to confidential discussions between the parties to

this case, which information relates to competitive interests and competitive business information.

- 3. Request for Production No. 2 contains confidential and proprietary cost studies of various services, which information also relates to BellSouth's competitive interests and competitive business information.
- 4. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed in that disclosure would cause harm to BellSouth's business operation and would impair BellSouth's ability to compete.
- 5. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification a listing showing the location in the response of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential as Attachment A.
- 6. Appended hereto in an envelope designated as Attachment B are two copies of the information with the confidential information redacted.
- 7. Attached as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the information with the material which is confidential and proprietary.
- 8. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the material for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth moves the Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential proprietary business information, and thus not subject to public disclosure.

#### **Explanation of Proprietary Information**

- 1. This information contains business information related to competitive interests of BellSouth that is proprietary to BellSouth. The documents contain actual unit cost information for discrete cost elements. Public disclosure of this information would provide BellSouth's competitors with an advantage in that they would know the price or rate below which BellSouth could not provide the service. The data is valuable to competitors and potential competitors in formulating strategic plans for entry, pricing, marketing, and overall business strategies concerning these services. This same information on competitors is not available to BellSouth. Disclosure of this data would impair the competitive business and cause harm to BellSouth. Consequently, this information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and is exempt from the Open Records Act.

Disclosure of this data would impair the competitive business of, and cause harm to, BellSouth. Consequently, this information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and is exempt from the Open Records Act.
