RE: Docket No. 991222-TP - Request for submission of proposals for relay service, beginning in June 2000, for the hearing and speech impaired, and other implementation matters in compliance with the Florida Telecommunications Access System Act of 1991.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve FTRI's proposed budget for the fiscal year 2004-2005 effective July 1, 2004?

Recommendation: No. The budget should not be approved as proposed by FTRI. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the budget as amended in Attachment A of its May 20, 2004 memorandum effective July, 2004, and that the TASA surcharge be increased from \$.13 to \$.15. Additionally, the local exchange companies, competitive local exchange companies, and shared tenant providers should be ordered to assess the \$.15 surcharge effective July 1, 2004.


