GTC, Inc. d/b/a GT Com ("GT Com") hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request for Confidential Classification, and states as follows:

1. On May 18, 2004, GT Com filed its Responses to PSC Staff's Data Request dated April 30, 2004. At the same time, GT Com filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of Certain Information contained therein. GT Com is now Requesting Confidential Classification of the subject information.

2. GT Com has appended to this request as Attachment "A" a highlighted paper copy of the documents for which confidential classification is requested.

3. GT Com has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment "B" two edited copies of the information which are available for public inspection.

4. The information requested concerns proprietary and confidential information between GT Com and GT Com's parent company, and NeuStar and Verisign, related to rates, terms, costs and other pertinent data. This data is valuable to ILECs, CLECs and potential competitors to NeuStar and Verisign in formulating strategic plans for entry, pricing, marketing and overall business strategies. This information is valuable to GT Com, its parent company, NeuStar and Verisign and is used by GT Com's parent company in conducting business and GT Com, NeuStar and Verisign strive to keep it secret. Therefore, this information should be classified as proprietary,

confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(a) and (e), Florida Statutes.

5. GT Com has treated, and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.
