AmeriVision Communications, Inc. d/b/a LifeLine Communications.

On December 22, 2003, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-03-1454-PAA-TI, made final and effective by Consummating Order No. PSC-04-0050-CO-TI, issued on January 20, 2004, in Docket No. 030960-TI, accepting AmeriVision Communications, Inc. d/b/a LifeLine Communications' offer of refund for apparent overcharges to end-users on intrastate calls made using calling card services.

The PAA Order required the company to issue refunds to the affected customers, with interest, and file a refund report with the Commission. In the event any monies were unrefundable, the company was required to remit the unrefundable amount to the Commission. The company refunded \$279.30 to its active customers, remitted \$168.80 to the Commission in unrefundable monies, and issued its final refund report on May 18, 2004, in compliance with the Commission's Orders. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
