TelCove's experience in entering the Florida local exchange market has been consistent with that of most other CLEC's. Interconnection negotiations with ILEC's have always been difficult, and the recent regulatory developments in Washington, D.C., have not improved the process. At this stage, TelCove most needs regulatory certainty so that it can tailor its business plans to the regulatory realities of the market. It is only with that regulatory certainty that TelCove can maximize its ability to provide viably competitive alternatives to the ILEC's.
