Labrador Utilities, Inc. ("Labrador"), provides the following response to Staff's data requests dated August 18, 2004:

**DATA REQUEST NO. 1:** Please explain why it is prudent to include each of the pro forma items requested which were, or will be, placed into service after the test year.

**RESPONSE:** Historically, the Commission has allowed the inclusion of such pro forma items, and their inclusion is consistent with prior Commission decisions. In addition, these projects have, or will, provide a number of benefits to the Utility's customers, therefore it is both reasonable and prudent to allow their inclusion. These benefits are described below.

The engineering consultant evaluated and provided recommendations regarding improvements to the existing electrical systems at both the WTP and WWTP. From these reports and on-site assessments, the engineer provided recommendations for an adequately sized generator, engine sets and fuel tank storage sizes. Electrical drawings and specifications detailing requirements for purchasing, permitting, and installing necessary

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generator set and electrical system improvements at the WTP and WWTP were provided. Once the evaluation was completed, construction support was provided during the construction process.

Install Generator at WTP, WO#160-693-115-03-01

Relocated a 100-kW generator from the Labrador WWTP site to the WTP. Performed preventative maintenance service on the WWTP generator prior to transfer. Install a used 400 Amp automatic transfer switch and disconnect at Labrador WTP. Installed a 300-gallon double-walled diesel fuel storage tank. Retired from service a 30-kW generator that was undersized, unreliable, and at the end of its service life. Implemented the recommendations identified in WO#160-693-115-02-02 regarding WTP electrical improvements in order to meet the FDEP regulatory requirement to provide an alternate source of power or water supply for community systems with greater than 150 connections.

WTP Improvements to pumps & GST, WO#160-693-115-04-01

Change one 20-Hp high service pump to 10 Hp. Install Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs) on the two 10 Hp high service pumps, upgrade pump controls for the high service pumps, and paint exterior of a ground storage tank at WTP. Repipe the suction manifolds to reduce pump cavitation conditions and thereby extend the service life of the high service pumps. These improvements are designed to address the absence of a hydro pneumatic tank at the site, which results in fluctuations in water pressure, excessive runtime of the smallest high service pump, and an elevated monthly power bill. The silo-shaped bolted steel ground storage tank needs to be sandblasted and painted. Also, the roof will be repaired.

Electrical Design for WTP Improvements - H.S. Pumps, WO#160-693-115-04-02

This WO is for engineering services to provide plans and specifications improvements to the high service pump controls. This project will include installing two (2) VFD drives, a new pump control panel and all associated electrical circuits mounted in an equipment storage building located adjacent to the high service pump house. The design plans will be utilized for bidding and construction phases of the project.

Install Generator and ATS at WWTP, WO#160-693-116-03-02

Purchased and installed a 150-kW generator, two 225-Amp automatic transfer switches, one 500-gallon double-walled fuel tank, main breaker, distribution panel and associated

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components at the Labrador WWTP. Consolidated the two existing electrical services into one service in order to reduce the monthly power bill. One large electric service now qualifies the plant for a reduced power rate as well as eliminating one of two electric accounts.

Replace media in traveling bridge filter, WO#160-693-116-04-01

Removed and replaced all of the porous under drain plates and piping when the filter media was removed and replaced. The existing sand media was removed and replaced with a 4-foot layer of sand and 2 inches of gravel to restore filter performance to its design specifications, and as required by the current operating permit.

Install new main breaker and electrical feed to a blower panel at the WWTP, WO#160-693-116-04-01

A new 3-pole 200-Amp breaker was installed in the distribution panel box at the new service rack constructed for the new generator and ATS installation (See WO # 116-03-02). A new 200-Amp feeder circuit was also installed between the new breaker and the existing process blower control panel inside the blower building. This new 200-Amp breaker separates the electric service that feeds the process blowers from the equipment load at the south end of the treatment plant. Prior to the completion of this project, all of the equipment at the south end of the plant including the process blowers was fed through a single undersized breaker that caught fire and was destroyed.

Engineering Design for WWTP Improvements, WO#160-693-116-04-03

Engineering services will be used to design modifications to the hydraulic flow pattern between and through the existing WWTP process tanks. Currently, all of the 11 aeration tanks must remain in service during the low flow summer months. Additionally, the project will include the design of splitter box modifications. The piping modifications will allow the plant to operate in parallel trains and more evenly distribute return activated sludge (RAS) to the three clarifiers. The current flow scheme and pipe configuration prevents the efficient use of tanks, blowers, and materials during the off season.

WWTP Improvements, WO#160-693-116-04-04

This project will implement the recommended improvements identified in WO#160-693-116-04-03. Install or reconfigure pipelines and valves that connect the various individual

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process units to allow plant flow to be split in parallel rather than in series. Reconfigure the sludge return lines to evenly distribute return activated sludge (RAS) evenly into each clarifier, improving settling. The flow will be divided so that proportional flow will be treated in each process train, so that treatment will be optimized with reduced operating cost.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 2:** Please provide a schedule that details the amounts and accounts for Major Maintenance Projects listed on Schedule B-11 of the MFR's. Please indicate whether or not each item listed was, or will be, capitalized or expensed.

**RESPONSE:** Please refer to attached schedule.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 3:** Please provide copies of work papers, calculations, and invoices supporting the proforma adjustments to salaries, benefits, insurance, taxes, and rent expense.

**RESPONSE:** Rent Expense - The Utility pays \$3,500 per month because the water and wastewater plant and spray irrigation fields are located on property owned by Forest Lake Estates. The general ledger shows a total yearly rent expense of \$37,483.87. This was due to credit received at closing. The actual yearly rent expense of \$42,000 should be included as an O&M expense. Please see attached work papers for the remaining support.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 4:** Please provide copies of work papers, calculations, and invoices supporting all proforma adjustments to plant.

**RESPONSE:** Please see enclosed general ledger detailing general ledger plant additions included in the rate case. Also, please refer to the capital projects ledger with costs to date. The Utility has also included two schedules to this response. One schedule shows the supporting calculations for pro forma plant and corresponding accumulated depreciation entries on MFR Schedule A-3, and the other schedule shows these calculations for updates and revisions.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 5:** Please indicate whether the utility has taken into consideration the tax impacts of the Job Creation and Worker Assistance Act of 2002, and the Jobs and Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2003. If so, please provide an explanation of any items considered and the resulting calculations of the current or deferred tax impacts for the test year on proforma plant additions.

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**RESPONSE:** The Utility did take advantage of the accelerated depreciation benefits associated with the Job Creation and Work Assistance Act of 2002, and the Jobs and Growth Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2003. The general effects of the accelerated tax benefit are incorporated in the accumulated deferred income tax balance on MFR Schedule D-1. The explanation of the items considered and the resulting calculations will be provided.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 6:** Please provide a legal description and sketch of the land used for Labrador's water and wastewater facilities. The description should include the exact dimensions and number of acres.

**RESPONSE:** Please refer to the attached documents. The water plant site comprises approximately 2 acres, and the wastewater treatment plant site comprises approximately 5 acres. The exact acreage will be determined and provided to Staff. Detailed system maps for the water and wastewater systems, showing the location of the water and wastewater facilities, have been provided to Staff.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 7:** Please provide documentation showing the original cost of the land used for Labrador's water and wastewater facilities at the time the land was first devoted to public service, i.e., the date the land was plotted or planned for construction or the date the construction commenced. If either of these dates is unknown, state such. If documentation showing the original cost of the land does not exist, please provide an appraisal as of the date the land was first devoted to public service but no later than 1989.

**RESPONSE:** Labrador Utilities, Inc., does not have any documentation showing the original cost of the land upon which the water and wastewater facilities are located when such facilities were first dedicated to public service. To Labrador's knowledge, the previous owner never had an appraisal of that land. The records of the Department of Environmental Protection reflect that the facility was permitted in 1986, and that the spray field was permitted in 1997. Labrador believes that these dates are reasonable and appropriate for establishing the dates on which the facility and spray field were first dedicated to public use. Should the Commission Staff require an appraisal using these dates, one will be commissioned.

Labrador believes that the current lease represents an arms-length transaction and should be accepted by the Commission in this proceeding, as it was when Labrador's predecessor was granted original certificates. In June 1999, Mr. Viau sold the mobile home community land, including the land upon which the water and wastewater facilities are located, to the Forest Lake Estates Co-Op, Inc. Unfortunately, Mr. Viau is not available to

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explain the rationale for selling the land, although one would logically expect that he would have negotiated the lowest lease payment he could. The lease is between the Co-Op and Labrador Services, Inc., and there were no related party issues in the transaction; thus, it must be concluded that it was an arms-length transaction.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 8:** Please provide documentation reflecting any discussions or negotiations between Utilities, Inc., and the seller of Labrador Services regarding the assignment of the land lease. Please provide documentation supporting discussions UI conducted in its due diligence or reflecting research performed or contracted to be performed by UI prior to agreeing to the lease assignment.

**RESPONSE:** The documentation which Labrador relied upon with regard to the reasonableness of the lease payment is Order No. PSC-01-1483-PAA-WS, wherein the Commission acknowledges the \$3,500 monthly rent:

Total rental amount is \$3,500 per month with provisions for indexing based upon the Consumer Price Index. (at page 13.)

In addition to relying on Commission Order No. PSC-01-1483-PAA-WS and the lease itself, UI conducted a site visit to inspect the leased property. After a review of UI's records, Labrador has located certain handwritten notes relating to the lease. A copy of these notes are attached.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 9:** Please provide a copy of the time sheets for all employees whose salaries are allocated to Labrador under the Water Service Corporation's Distribution of Expenses Manual Code S.E. 50, Distribution of Direct Salary, from January 1, 2003, to June 30, 2004.

**RESPONSE:** The operators listed under SE 50 do not fill out time sheets for allocation of all of their salary. They do, however, fill out time sheets to properly allocate their capitalized time.

**DATA REQUEST NO. 10:** Please state whether the vehicle that is assigned to the Labrador facility is shared or used at any other Utilities, Inc. facilities. If so, please explain and provide any documentation of the sharing arrangement.

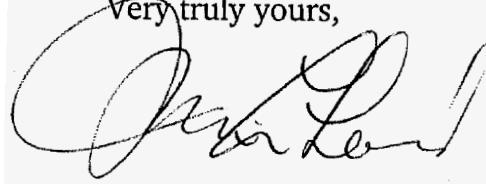
**RESPONSE:** The vehicle that is assigned and contained in Labrador's financials is not
