Control No. 04-044-2-2, Documents Numbered 08247-04 and 08598-04

On July 17, 2004, when copies of certain portions of staff's working papers obtained or prepared during the "Progress Energy Florida Inc. Environmental Cost Recovery Clause Audit for the Year Ended December 31, 2003", were delivered to PEF at the audit exit conference, the utility requested that these materials be temporarily exempted from public access in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)2., Florida Administrative Code (FAC).

On July 29, 2004, staff filed documents 08247-04 consisting of those specified portions of the staff working papers.

On August 6, 2004, PEF filed a request pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S), and Rule 25-22.006(3)(A)(2.) AND (4.), FAC, that selected portions of the working papers prepared by the staff during the audit receive confidential classification. The utility's request included redacted copies for public inspection (document 08597-04) and highlighted copies (document 08598-04).

Subsection 366.093, F.S., provides; "Proprietary confidential business information means information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public. Proprietary confidential business information includes but is not limited to:

(d) Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms"

According to Section 366.093, F.S., and Rule 25-22.006, FAC, the utility has the burden of demonstrating that materials qualify for confidential classification. According to Rule 25-22.006, FAC, the utility must meet this burden by demonstrating that the information is proprietary confidential business information, the disclosure of which will cause the utility, the provider of the information or the ratepayer harm.

Staff Analysis of the Request

Reading the PEF filing reveals the sensitive material consists of:

Contractual data, such as rates, total costs related to commodities purchased from, and services rendered by, outside firms.

Subsection 366.093(d), F. S., provides that the Commission may grant a confidential classification to sensitive contractual information to include bidding information if release of that information will impair the ability of the utility or its affiliates to contract on favorable terms.

PEF identifies the material associated with sensitive contractual information as reported within staff working papers entitled: "Invoices from Viasys Utility Services", "Invoices from Pike Electric & Viasys Utility Services", "Qore Inc. Contract", "Invoice(s) from Pike Electric", "Contract with Southern Waste Services", "Contract with Viasys", "Contract with Pike Electric", and "Contract with Osmose." PEF pleads that release of this contractual data, "either alone or in conjunction with non confidential information on other work papers (such as vendor timesheets or quantities purchased) would give potential vendors sensitive information which would place the company at a competitive disadvantage when negotiating with such vendors in the future...."

After reading the material identified by PEF, we agree that release of this material would reasonably be expected to impair the ability of PEF or its affiliates to contract favorably for goods and services. We therefore recommend that the material be granted a confidential classification on the basis that the material meets the exemption provided by Subsection 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes.

Information Held as Confidential

To qualify as proprietary confidential business information the material must also be held as private and not be released to the public. PEF asserts that this information "is considered confidential and is maintained as such."

Duration of the Confidential Classification Period

PEF requests that this material be returned to the utility once the information is no longer needed for the Commission to conduct its business. However, we note the Commission staff's working papers for this type of audit are retained on file by the Commission for 25 years.

According to the provisions of Section 366.093(4), F.S., absent good cause shown, confidential classification is limited to 18 months. Without cause shown for a longer period, we recommend that the period of confidential classification be set as 18 months. As deemed necessary, the utility may request an extension of the confidential classification before the period tolls.

Staff Recommendation

Based upon reading the filing, and for the reasons presented above, we recommend the utility's request be granted and that the identified material be granted a confidential classification for 18 months.
