PURPOSE AND PROCEDUE :

The purpose of this rearing will be for the Commission to take final action to determine the need, pursuant to Section 403.519, Florida Statutes, for Progress Energy's propose 3 electrical power plant in Polik County, Florida, This proceeding shall allow Progress Energy to present evidence and testimony in support of its petition for a determination of need for its proposed electrical power plant; to permit any Intervenors to present testimony and exhibits concerning this matter, to permit members of the public who are not parties to the need determination proceeding the opportunity to present testimony concerning this matter, and for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

The proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, Section 403.519, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-22 and 28-106, Florida Administrative Cade.

Under Section 403.519, the Commission is the sole forum for the determination of need for the proposed electrical power plant, in making its determination, the Commission must take into account the need for electric system reliability and integrity, the need for adequate electricity of a reasonable cost, and whether in a proposed plant expansion is the most cost-effective alternative evallable, in addition. The Commission must expressly consider the conservation meanings taken by or reasonably available to the applicants which might mitigate the need for the proposed plant and may consider other matters within its jurisdiction which if deems relevant. The Commission's determination of need for the proposed plant shall create a presumption of public need and in cessity and shall serve as the Commission's report required by subsection 403,507(2)(a)(2, Florida Statutes. An order entered by the Commission pursuant to this hearing shall constitute final agency action.

Only Issues relating to the need for the proposed power plant will be heard at this hooring. Separate public hearings will be held before the Division of Administrative Rearings at a later date to consider environmental and other impacts of the proposed plant and associated facilities.

Members of the public who are not parties to the need determination proceeding will have an opportunity to present testimony regarding the need for the proposed plant. All members of the public who wish to offer testimony should be present at the baginning of the nearing, 9:30 a.m., Wednesday, November 3, 2004, All with assess will be sworn in and will be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.
