And we have a "right" as a neighborhood to "peaceful enjoyment" of our property. We do not know the health hazards that such smells represent to our children and families and why it cannot be controlled. We have a right to be able to walk our neighborhood at night without it being affected. Certainly, if there are pollution methods to "scrub" coal fired plants then there are certainly methods to take care of the odor issues.

My concern also is if there have been any spills in the plant. And why on the weekends? Why the lack of communication to neighborhoods and Why the lack of presence of personnel ??

Area of Improvement #2.

Effort should be made to make the plant less visible thereby limiting the appearance factor. Berms are not enough as that is what surrounds the front. Instead, there should be proper vegetation, trees and landscaping in the front to visually obscure the plant so that the neighborhood is not devalued.

I would like a response to all of these concerns. Possibly a response line could be set up directly to the plant informing them of the smell issue. Several times I have been told that the deodorizer has failed and is inoperative. Why is that so?

My neighborhood and I are not willing anymore to put up with this and should this not be addressed we are joining to move on several fronts to solve the problems. These are problems that require attention and I cannot believe that our health is not jeopardized by the smell for certainly the air carries viruses.

We are opposed to any increase until these issues are resolved. My entire neighborhood including my wife and five children are opposed.

This is our opinion.



Thank you, for your letter dated February 26, 2003. I would like to take this opportunity to address the concerns raised in your letter. It appears that your main concern is that the utility's charge of \$5.04 a month for residential reuse availability is "unjust" and should not be charged by the utility. Section 367.091(4), Florida Statutes, specifies that a utility may only impose and collect those rates and charges approved by the Commission for the particular class of service involved. The Commission approved a reuse availability charge in Order No. PSC-98-0391-FOF-SU, issued March 16, 1998, in Docket No. 960288-SU, for this utility. (See Attached Order)

Section 367.091(3), Florida Statutes, specifies that each utilities rates, charges, and customer service policies must be contained in a tariff approved by and on file with the Commission. The utility has on file with the Commission a tariffed residential reuse availability charge of \$5.04 per month.

Your second question addressed why customers should pay for reuse if they are not using it. Reuse has been encouraged by the Commission as well as the five water management districts as a means to conserve water. For this reason, we believe that all water users in Florida benefit from reuse. The benefit is also reflected in Section 367.0817(3), Florida Statutes, which specifies that:

All prudent costs of a reuse project shall be recovered in rates. The Legislature finds that reuse benefits water, wastewater, and reuse customers. The Commission shall allow a utility to recover the cost of a reuse project from the utility's water, wastewater, or reuse customers or any combination thereof as deemed appropriate by the Commission.



On January 10, 2003, Alafaya Utilities, Inc. (Alafaya or utility) filed an application for approval of interim and permanent rate increases with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC or Commission). Alafaya provides wastewater service to approximately 5,600 residential customers and 100 general service customers in Seminole County. Alafaya is located in the city of Oviedo and is approximately eight miles northeast of Orlando.

The current rate case is being processed under the PSC's "Proposed Agency Action" (PAA) procedure. Under the PAA process, the case will not be set for a formal hearing unless a timely protest to the Commission's proposed agency action is filed.

On March 4, 2003, the PSC voted to suspend the utility's request for a permanent rate increase, but approved an interim rate increase of \$46,387, to allow the utility to maintain financial integrity for the period of the investigation of the requested rate increase. The interim rate increase may be subject to refund after the Commission completes its investigation.

On Wednesday, March 12, 2003, the staff of the PSC will hold a customer meeting for the purpose of providing customers and other interested persons an opportunity to comment and ask questions regarding the utility's

proposed rate increase and quality of service.

Based upon Alafaya's requested rates, a residential bill for 10,000 gallons of wastewater would increase from \$30.45 to \$35.78. In accordance with Florida Statutes, the PSC will consider the utility's quality of service and other matters in this case.

PSC staff is scheduled to make a recommendation to the Commission on May 22, 2003, and the Commission vote on this matter is scheduled for June 3, 2003.



Thank you for your letter dated March 14, 2003. It appears that your major concerns are with the lack of reclaimed (reuse) water availability to your residence and the use of water usage to assess the wastewater rates because it does not represent the actual amount of wastewater returned for treatment. Customer comments are an integral part of our investigation. Your comments as well as all others will be considered when staff prepares its recommendation on Alafaya Utilities, Inc.'s (Alafaya) proposed rates.

With regard to the availability of reclaimed water, a utility is not required by this Commission to provide reclaimed water. Section 367.111(1), Florida Statutes, states in pertinent part that "each utility shall provide service to the area described in its certificate of authorization within a reasonable time." Since the provision of reclaimed water is not certificated, the Commission does not have the authority to require a utility to provide reclaimed water. In addition, all the customers of a given utility cannot receive reclaimed water because it is limited to the amount of treated wastewater effluent. It takes the treated wastewater effluent of approximately four residential customers to provide reclaimed water for one residential customer.

The provision of reclaimed water is being used by utilities as a means of disposal for its wastewater effluent, which is the case for Alafaya. However, the primary reason for utilizing reclaimed water is for conservation purposes. The utilization of reclaimed water reduces the demand on Florida's aquifers.

Section 367.0817(1), Florida Statutes, states that a utility may submit a reuse project plan for Commission approval. In 1996, Alafaya submitted its reuse plan to the Commission. The Commission approved the utility's reuse plan and charges in Order No. PSC-98-0391-FOF-SU, issued March 16, 1998, in Docket No. 960288-SU. In that Order, the approved reuse plan was to make reuse available to several developments, as well as an undeveloped tract. Further, it was

estimated that it would take approximately two years to construct and place the expanded reuse system in service.

In April 2002, reuse water was made available to the Ekana Green and Waverly Woods subdivisions, for which 53 customers are actually accepting reuse water now. Due to a Florida Department of Transportation road widening project that includes a bridge over the Econlockhatchee River, Alafaya was delayed in completing its planned main extension. The utility anticipates completion of this main extension by April 2003, which will make reuse water available to The Sanctuary at River Oaks and Live Oak developments. Based on a discussion with Alafaya, your residence is in the Twin Rivers subdivision which was not included in the reuse plan approved by the Commission.

With regard to the use of water usage data to assess Alafaya's wastewater rates, the Commission has recognized that not all the water usage is returned to the wastewater treatment plant. In fact, Alafaya's wastewater rate structure was designed to address this concern in two ways. First, the rates were designed to assume that only 80% of the water is returned to the wastewater treatment plant. Second, Alafaya's residential wastewater gallonage charge is capped at 10,000 gallons. Thus, if a customer's water usage is 15,000 gallons for the month, the customer is only charged for 10,000 gallons. Further, if you do not currently have a separate meter on your irrigation system, you might want to consider having one installed by the City of Oviedo. A separate meter should also address your concern regarding the amount of effluent actually being returned to Alafaya's wastewater treatment plant.
