Mad Hatter Utility, Inc. (MHU) is instituting use of radio read metering systems in portions of its service territory where use of those new metering devices are practicable. As such, we are requesting a change in meter installation fees in order to recognize the cost differential for the new metering systems. While we are doing this, we are also updating the meter installation fee cost for existing standard meter installation fees where those will continue to be used. We are requesting approval of both new meter installation fees with this filing. Cost justification, tariffs, and documentation of the material cost from the supplier are attached hereto as justification for these changes.

We are also enclosing proposed changes in the miscellaneous service charges. Those have not been updated in over 15 years and costs for fuel and labor have risen substantially since that last update. The Commission's price index alone has increased approximately 60% in that period of time. As such, we are also requesting a change in miscellaneous service charges in order to reflect those changes. Included with those miscellaneous service charges is a Premises Visit Charge modified to recognize those situations in which the Utility is requested by the customer to visit the premises and it is determined that the problem or the service rendered is not related to the Utility's facilities but rather to the customer's side of the meter. In addition, we are requesting after hours charges of \$40 for each of these services, which we understand have recently been authorized for other similarly situated utilities.

Please approve these as quickly as possible. If you have any questions in this regard, please let me know.
