Let me just take a moment -- before I ask for any opening statements from either of the parties, let me just see if we have anyone here seeking to be heard. None?

Well, Commissioners, let's do this, let's go on recess for, until about, let's do 20 after, and then we'll come back and see where we are from that point. So we're on recess.
