1 **25-6.0346 Quarterly Reports of Work Orders and Safety Compliance**

2 (1) Each investor-owned electric utility, rural electric cooperative and municipal
3 electric utility shall report all completed electric work orders, whether completed by the utility
4 or one of its contractors, at the end of each quarter of the year. The report shall be
5 electronically filed with the Director of the Division of Safety, Reliability and Consumer
6 Assistance no later than the 30th working day after the last day of the reporting quarter using
7 Form PSC/SRC 157 (xx/12), "PSC Quarterly Report of Completed Work Orders," which is
8 available at <http://www.flrules.org/Gateway/reference.asp?No=Ref-xxxxx>. This form is
9 incorporated into this rule by reference, and may also be obtained from the Commission's
10 Division of Administrative Services.

11 (2) In its quarterly report, each utility shall identify all transmission and distribution
12 facilities subject to the Commission's safety jurisdiction, and shall certify to the Commission
13 that they meet or exceed the applicable standards. Compliance inspections by the Commission
14 shall be made on a random basis or as appropriate.
