Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 02705-15

On May 8, 2015, Florida Public Utilities Company, Florida Public Utilities Company – Indiantown Division, Florida Public Utilities Company – Ft. Meade, and the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (joint petitioners) filed a joint request for confidential classification for Document No. 02705-15. This document contains responses to staff's first data request. The information in the document for which the joint petitioners seek confidential treatment relates to specific system function and capacity information, as well as information regarding the costs associated therewith. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with the joint petitioners that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes (F.S.), whereby disclosure of the information would be harmful to the competitive business operations of the joint petitioners.

Therefore, staff recommends that the joint request of the joint petitioners for confidential classification of Document No. 02705-15 be approved. Staff notes that the joint petitioners also stated that Section 366.093(3)(c), F.S., would apply to the information; however, staff did not evaluate the applicability of this statutory provision since the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
