Re: Docket No. 20200226-SU - Application for certificate to provide wastewater service in Charlotte County, by Environmental Utilities, LLC.

Dear Mr. Friedman:

Staff has reviewed Environmental Utilities, LLC's application for original certificate. After reviewing this information, we find the application to be deficient. The specific deficiencies are identified as:

- 1. **Filing Fee.** Rule 25-30.020(2)(a)3., Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), requires a filing fee of \$2,250 be submitted for an original certificate application for utilities with the existing or proposed capacity to serve from 2,001 to 4,000 ERCs. Please submit an additional filing fee of \$750 for wastewater service.
- 2. **Legal Description.** Rule 25-30.029(2)(b)2., F.A.C., requires that all points of beginning must be in reference to a section corner or a subsection corner. Please revise all points of beginning to comply with this rule.
- 3. **Territory Map**. Rule 25-30.033(1)(j)2, F.A.C., requires that the system map of territory proposed to be served is consistent with the legal description provided. Upon review, staff found that the following items need to be corrected: 1) Map Exhibit B (within Exhibit G of the application) as well as the legal description of the northern boundary of Cape Haze does not match the territory map provided. Section 27; 2) Township 42 South, Range 20 East, is referenced in the legal description but not labeled on the territory map; and 3) Gasparilla Sound is referenced in the legal description but not labeled on the territory map.
- 4. **Notice of Application.** Rule 25-30.030(6), F.A.C., states that all applications requiring noticing shall be deemed deficient until affidavits of noticing required by Sections 367.045(1)(e) and (2)(f), Florida Statutes, along with a copy of the notice, are filed with the Office of Commission Clerk. After staff has reviewed and approved the notice of

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application, and the notices have been distributed in accordance with Rule 25-30.030(5), F.A.C., please provide affidavits of noticing.

Your application will not be deemed filed until the deficiencies identified in this letter have been corrected. These corrections should be submitted no later than **December 11, 2020.** Please provide the corrected maps and territory description electronically via the Commission's website at www.floridapsc.com, by selecting the Clerk's Office tab and Electronic Filing Web Form (reference Docket No. 20200226-SU) as well as physically to the following address:
