Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company (TECO or Company) requests confidential classification for certain highlighted information contained in responses to OPC's 2<sup>nd</sup> request for PODs (Nos. 19-33).

The Company is claiming confidentiality for certain highlighted information appearing in Document No. 08282-2021 under Section 366.093(3), F.S. Per the referenced Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) "Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms." The highlighted information provided in Document No. 08282-2021 for which confidential treatment is being sought consists of a scope of work document for a solar cost study that was prepared pursuant to a contract between Black & Veatch and Tampa Electric. The Company asserts that this document contains confidential pricing data and is labeled as proprietary and confidential by Black & Veatch. Public disclosure of this contractual document would impair the efforts of Tampa Electric to contract for similar services on favorable terms in the future.

Staff has reviewed the information provided in the highlighted portions of the Company's response to OPC's 2<sup>nd</sup> request for PODs (Nos. 19-33) as well as the Company's confidentiality request (Document No. 08281-2021). In staff's opinion, the information that is the subject of the confidentiality request does meet the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of information included in Document No. 08282-2021 be approved.
