Recently you approved a ruling to allow Florida Power & Light Company to allow for a minimum billing of \$25 to all metered residential customers whose monthly base electric service costs fall below \$25.

Can you please explain to me why you approved this minimum billing. Especially now at a time during high inflation times and the possibility of a Recession. FPL has charged me a base billing on my most recent billing for May 23 to June 22, 2022 in addition to this minimum residential billing of \$ 25.

This represents a double minimum billing fee. It should be a \$25 without a minimum base billing. I have advised my displeasure with this policy to FPL. Please reconsider this practice in your latest implemented approved policy.
