Please accept this correspondence in strong protest against the Application for Certificate to Operate Water and/or Wastewater Utility under Document # 20240011 (Riverdale Utility Holding). As a resident that lives within 2 miles of the proposed location, we have the following concerns;

1. Based upon the exhibits attached to the application, the SJRWMD permit and water commitment from the County are stale and the permits have expired.

2. The location of the proposed utility is in an area that is environmentally sensitive. The groundwater drains into the nearby St. Johns River, which has experienced unusual algae blooms and decreased marine vegetation in the past 10 years. This proposed utility will only exacerbate a current problem.

3. There are many protected species in the area that could be harmed, including a thriving bald eagle population. As well as the ever diminishing protected manatee population.

4. Many of the nearby residential properties exceed \$1 Million value, and this utility could significantly depress the values without corresponding compensation or benefit to the current residents that outweighs the potential detriments to the public – harm to the ecosystem, odor, noise, accidental discharge or contamination, harm to the air and water quality.
