TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION AND REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests confidential classification of certain highlighted information contained in the company's answer to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories, No. 1 (Bates Stamp pages 14-42).

- 1. Along with this Request, Tampa Electric is providing, on a confidential basis, a single copy of the company's response to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories, No. 1 (Bates Stamp page 14-42).
- 2. Subsection 366.093(1), Florida Statutes, provides that any records "found by the Commission to be proprietary confidential business information shall be kept confidential and shall be exempt from s.119.07(1) [requiring disclosure under the Public Records Act]." The proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to:
 - (e) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. (Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes)
- 3. The Confidential Information falls within the above statutory category and, thus constitutes proprietary confidential business information entitled to protection under Section 366.093 and Rule 25-22.006. The exhibit contains details regarding Tampa Electric's Root Cause Analysis. The disclosure of this information would be harmful to competitive interests,

and as such, the information is entitled to confidential treatment pursuant to Section 366.093(e), Florida Statutes and 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

- 4. Tampa Electric treats the Confidential Information as such and has not disclosed it publicly.
- 5. For the same reasons set forth herein in support of its request for confidential classification, Peoples also moves the Commission for entry of a Temporary Protective Order pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(a) of the Florida Administrative Code.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests that the yellow highlighted Confidential Information contained in the company's response to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories, No. 1 (Bates Stamp Pages 14-42) be afforded confidential classification for the reasons set forth above.
